The Municipal Street Lighting Legislation has passed through committee.

Main Street Lighting – The manufacturer, Hallowell, is providing the city with two samples of the latest design of the LED street lights. A pole with nothing on it is at the end of Glover's Passage.

The study of lighting on Main Street is to be delivered any day now.

The Committee reviewed the Thorndike Parking Area Lighting Recommendations of February 8, 2011. (The governor is still holding up the Thorndike Parking Project funding.)

Library HVAC – Leaks have been detected in the cooling system between the chiller and the building.

There are solar gain situations in the new wing that are now evident since the heating systems improvements have been completed. The two staff areas are still overheating. Snow is still getting into the building near the exhaust / intake air ducts. The chiller will need to be replaced, so a reserve account or CIP planning should be considered.
