

Minutes of August 7, 2014, Parks Commission Meeting

The minutes of July 10, 2014, were read and approved. John made to motion and Alison seconded the motion. The vote was approved.

A brief discussion was had concerning plane traffic on Chickawaukie Pond. Rene provided the Commission with information about the issue.

John has been researching putting a Holiday tree in Ulmer Park. Terry made a motion to ask City Council if they would entertain the concept of putting a temporary tree in Ulmer Park. John seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

Two more picnic tables are being donated, as reported by John.

Terry reported that about 500 gallons a day of human sewage is being discharged off of Snow Marine Park. The dog residue situation has been corrected, but the park needs to be closed until the e-coli problem is resolved.

The flowers in baskets on Main Street should start the FRP process. The baskets on Park Street look fine, the flower baskets on Main Street look horrible. Terry and Rene will research the situation. Home Depot would like to make a bid on the flower basket for next year.

Terry made a motion to notify the City Manager of tripping and falling hazards in Winslow – Holbrook Park. Alison seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.
