The minutes of the July 8th, 2015 meeting were approved.

HT Committee discussed additional parallel parking spaces in Thorndike Parking Lot. The Committee would like to formally make a recommendation against including these spaces.

The HT Committee would like to coordinate the art bench project with the Parks Commission.

Coast Week Event – The event is scheduled for September 20th. Annette met with Jared Cowan of Resisting Entropy who will organize a group of artists to take found materials to Snow Marine Park, spend Saturday assembling them and present the sculpture created by the group on Sunday.

Audra & Annette to work on a press release for the event that also highlights Resisting Entropy's contribution in addition to Coast Week event.

Audra will speak to Captain Sharpe about permission to use his space under the tent in case of rain.

The City will help dispose of the debris from the Sculpture – public works to bring a truck and workers to help with cleanup.

The sculpture will be assembled in the grassy island in the middle of Snow Marine Park. Public Works will supply cones and caution tape to cordon the materials and sculpture off.

The schedule for the event will be as follows:

- 10am – Ribbon Cutting for Opening of Mechanic Street
- 10:10 am to 12pm – Clean up of Snow Marine Park shoreline, Sandy Beach, shoreline in front of Boston Financial near Boardwalk
- 12pm to 1pm – Cookout
- 1pm to 2pm – Presentation of Art Installation
